

In order to reduce risk of fire, burns, electric shock or injury to others, please abide by the following instructions:

- 1. Be sure to unplug the unit when it is unattended. Ensure that it is left unplugged when not in use or before installing or removing any parts.
- 2. Children and any person requiring special care should use this unit under adult supervision.
- 3. Be sure to use this unit for the purposes described in this manual. Please do not install parts and accessories not provided by the manufacturer.
- 4. This unit must not be used under these conditions:
 - a) the power cord or plug is damaged;
 - b) the unit is malfunctioning or operating incorrectly;
 - c) the unit is damaged or exposed to water.
 - Contact our service center for inspection and repair.
- 5. Do not move this massage chair by pulling the power cord or using the cord as a handle.
- 6. Be sure to keep the power cord away from any source of heat.
- 7. Do not use this unit when the air outlet is blocked. Please keep the air outlet unblocked and free from hair and dust.
- 8. Do not drop or insert any objects into any opening.
- 9. Do not use this product outdoors.
- 10. Do not use this product in areas where aerosol products are used or oxygen is being released.
- 11. To power off, please switch off all controls before unplugging.
- 12. Please do not stand on or in the unit. It can only be used in a seated position.
- 13. Be sure to supervise children and ensure that they do not use the unit as a toy or for playing.
- 14. Connect this unit to a properly grounded outlet only. See Grounding Instructions (Page 17).
- 15. 
General Safety Precautions:






Power Button





- Do not operate the controller by using sharp-edged or hard objects. It may result in damage.






Body Scanning Interface








INSTALLATION METHOD

STEP 1: Unpack All Parts

- ► Carefully lift the chair and all of its parts from packaging.
- ▶ Remove any protective wrapping and check to make sure that all parts are present.
- ▶ Before beginning installation, please verify all components are included.

Step 2: Install the controller

Connect the cable of the remote with the cable under the seat.






- ▶ Press down to align the snap.




Step 4: Install the Backrest Pad and Pillow

- ▶ Attach the pillow pad to the backresby connecting the velcro.








BEFORE USING THE MASSAGE CHAIR FOR THE FIRST TIME

- ▶ Make sure there are no objects, people, or pets in the vicinity of the unit.
- Check that the chair has room to recline. Allow at least 14 in. of open space infront of the legrest and 5 in. behind the backrest.
- ► Use the controller to lower the backrest to its furthest outstretched position.
- Raise the legrest to its highest position. Make sure that the legrest is properly connected to the chair.
- ▶ Press the power button to return the chair to its original, upright position.



MASSAGE CHAIR PLACEMENT


- ▶ Ensure adequate space to recline.
- ► Do not expose the massage lounger to direct sunlight or high temperatures, such as infront of heating sources because this can cause discoloration or hardening of the synthetic leather.
- ▶ Place the unit on a mat to pevent floor damage.
- ▶ Install the unit near a power socket.
- ▶ Be sure to place the chair within 4ft of a power plug.


MOVE METHOD 1

- ▶ Turn off the main power and unplug the power from the electrical outlet.
- Tilt the chair backwards as shown below and wheel to desired location. Be sure to cover the floor with a mat when moving the massage chair to not damage the floor.



MOVE METHOD 2

- Two people reach under the chair on each side of the arms and hold the steel frame to avoid damage to the rest of the chair.
- ▶ Move to desired location and carefully place the chair on the ground.



- ▶ Do not attempt to move the chair while someone is still sitting on it.
- ▶ Do not move the chair by pulling its armrests, as the armrests can dislodge.
- Before plugging it in, inspect the entire power cord and plug for any possible damage. Make sure that no electrical wires are exposed.
- Make sure that the power supply switch is turned OFF before inserting the power plug into a wall outlet.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS


This unit must be grounded. If it should malfunction or breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

TURNING ON THE POWER

- ▶ Plug the power cord into the port at the base of the chair.
- ▶ Plug the three-pronged power plug into a properly grounded three-pronged power outlet.
- ▶ Flip on the power supply switch, located on the back of the massage chair at the base of the backrest.

DANGER

- ▶ This product is for use on a nominal 100-240V circuit and has a grounding plug that looks like the plug illustrated. Make sure that the product is connected to an outlet having the same configuration as the plug. No adapter should be used with this product.
- ► Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or serviceman if you are in doubt as to whether the product is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the product - if it will not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician.

PRODUCT STORAGE AND MAINTENANCE

CLEANING

- ▶ Before cleaning, switch OFF power and remove the power plug from the wall outlet.
- ▶ Dip a soft, cotton cloth in neutral detergent and wring dry. Use it to wipe the pillow cushion, back cushion, armrests, legrests, and any plastic parts of the chair.
- Use a piece of wet cloth (without detergent) to re-wipe the pillow cushion and back cushion.
- ▶ Use a soft, dry cloth to re-wipe the armrests, legrests, and any plastic parts of the chair.
- ▶ Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the controller, and the power supply box.
- ▶ To clean the foot/calf unit covers, remove them from the chair, hand wash with mild detergent and hang dry.

CAUTION

- ▶ Before any maintenance, always disconnect the power plug from the wall outlet.
- ▶ To avoid electric shock, never touch the power plug with wet hands.
- ▶ When cleaning the back cover of the massage chair, do not allow any detergent to seep into the power supply box.
- ▶ Do not use abrasive chemicals, such as benzene or alcohol, to clean this chair. Damage to the chair may result.
- Do not apply an iron or any other heated device to the chair.

STORAGE

When not in use, be sure to switch off power and detach the power plug from the wall outlet. Before putting into storage, wipe off all accumulated dirt and dust from the surface of the chair. Cover the entire surface of the chair with a dust cover (not included).

CAUTION

- ▶ Do not store the product under direct sunlight, nor in a location with high temperatures. Doing so may cause the upholstery to fade.
- Do not allow massage chair to remain in contact with vinyl or wallpaper for extended periods of time as this could lead to discoloration.

MAINTENANCE

Upon detecting any of the following conditions during daily use, immediately turn off power, disconnect the power plug from the wall outlet, and contact an authorized repairman:

TROUBLESHOOTING

		Bluetooth didn't connect with the music device.	Reconnect to the Bluetooth.
5	Backrest or footrest cannot ride or recline.	Excessive load has been pressed on the backrest or legrest.	Reduce the load and try again later.

If problems persist after applying the suggestions above, turn off power and remove the power plug from the wall outlet. Then contact the manufacturer for maintenance and repair.


